

Notice to Mariners No 08/24

ARDERSIER PORT REDEVELOPMENT Removal of Old Quay wall piling (DIVING OPPS)

Mariners are advised that Ardersier Port is being redeveloped into an Energy Transition Port and remains closed to commercial and leisure traffic until works are completed.

Large scale Quay works, and dredging operations are planned and updated Notices to Mariners will be published as works progress.

Following construction of a new Quay wall, built ashore and behind the original Quayside, the 1970's original Quay wall and sheet piling will be removed as the next stage of this project.

Diving works will be conducted in the vicinity of the hard stock.

Statom group have engaged TMS Maritime (Teignmouth Maritime Services) as Diving contractors.

Diving operations are expected to start on Monday 25th November and conclude on Monday 2nd December, between 0700-1900 daily.

A safety Rib will be deployed displaying the "A" flag when Diving operations are being conducted.

All vessels are to navigate with extreme caution when passing this area and to proceed at minimum speed to maintain steerage way.
